DEPOSIT LICENSE

Concession of Rights

I hereby grant Johannes Gutenberg University (JGU) Mainz the right to make my document accessible for free use on the internet according to the licensing conditions below. Within the scope of this right, the continued and subsequent use of the document is permitted under the conditions of subsequent use which have been selected by me and are included in the document's metadata. I hereby affirm that I am the author or that I have been authorized by the author or co-author to submit and grant these rights.

License Conditions:

1. Concession of Rights

The author grants JGU the irrevocable, non-exclusive right to make the publication accessible to the public for an unlimited time, to archive it on JGU's document server and to duplicate it for these purposes. With this license, the protection through copyright remains intact. The upload of the document does not result in a legally binding right for the publication to be made available or to be archived.

2. Long-term Archiving and Conversion into Different Formats

The author grants JGU the right to store the provided documents in their own long-term archives and, if necessary (in case of migration, accessibility, better access or indexing, for example), to convert the documents into other electronic and physical formats.



3. Transfer of Metadata and Documents

The author grants JGU the right to make the document's metadata available to other databases free of charge. Furthermore, they grant JGU the right to make the document available to third parties within the framework of national collection mandates, for purposes of long-term archiving, for online accessibility, or archiving.

4. Third-Party Rights

In the case of co-authorship, the author confirms that – before authorizing any further individuals to submit the document – they obtained the required consent to the publication of the document on the document server from their co-authors. The author declares that the rights of third parties (such as co-authors, publishing houses, copyright collectives, external funding providers) are not violated by making the document and its components (such as images) available. The author guarantees that the document does not contain the personal data of third parties covered by underlying data protection laws, or that consent for the use of personal data has been granted (see below). The author affirms they will inform JGU without delay in cases of doubt or if such legal obstacles should arise. The author absolves JGU of any third-party claims. JGU has the right to block and delete the document in case of concrete signs of a violation of third-party rights.

5. Subsequent Removal of the Publication

In exceptional cases, the author can apply for their publication to be removed if this is also in JGU's interest. The removal can only take place once this application has been approved by the University Library. In case of removal from the University Library and the DNB, no guarantee can be made that no copy still exists on the internet.

6. Additional Regulations for examination papers

6.1. If the document is an examination paper, the author guarantees that the submitted electronic version is identical with the approved original version. Those parts of the documents which are subject to data protection are exempted.

6.2. Advisor recommendation

If the document is a master's thesis, the publication can only take place once an email has been sent from the supervisor's email address to publikationssysteme@ub.uni-mainz.de containing the name of the supervisor, the degree program, and the explicit recommendation to publish the master's thesis.



Data Protection:

The author guarantees that the document does not contain the personal data of third parties covered by underlying data protection laws or that all necessary consents for the use of personal data have been obtained. The author indemnifies JGU from any claims by third parties. This includes any necessary legal defense costs (e.g. court and attorney's fees).
